

## **BRIGHTON & HOVE ALBION F.C. PEN PICTURES**

**MARK BEENEY — GOALKEEPER — D.O.B. 30.12.76**

Signed just before the transfer deadline in March 1991 for £20,000 from Maidstone. He has made more than 60 appearances in the Football League.

**STUART MYALL — DEFENDER — D.O.B. 12.11.74**

A first year Youth Team player from Eastbourne who is also an accomplished County Youth Cricketer.

**STUART TUCK — DEFENDER — D.O.B. 01.10.74**

Brighton born full back who signed a Youth Team contract last July.

**MARK BARHAM — WINGER — D.O.B. 12.07.62**

Joined the club on a trial basis at the end of December 1989 but quickly established himself in the first team and was immediately offered a contract. Mark is best remembered for his nine seasons with Norwich City FC during which time he was selected twice for England. He was picked during the 1982 tour of Australia. In recent seasons he has had brief spells with Huddersfield FC, Middlesbrough FC and West Bromwich Albion FC.

**STEFAN IOVAN — CENTRAL DEFENDER — D.O.B. 23.08.60**

Rumanian International signed from Steaua Bucharest for £60,000 in March 1991 after a long wrangle to obtain a work permit. Played more than 300 games at Club level in Rumania and has 34 full international caps.

**GREG O'DOWD — DEFENDER — D.O.B. 16.03.73**

From Home Farm, Dublin. Has represented the Republic of Ireland at youth level and is destined to follow in the footsteps of Paul McCarthy and Derek McGrath. A former trainee.

**PETER REED — DEFENDER — D.O.B. 27.10.72**

Former West Ham trainee who came on trial to the Goldstone at the beginning of the 1991-92 season. After a few encouraging performances in the reserves he signed a contract until the end of the season.

**JOHN ROBINSON — MIDFIELD — D.O.B. 29.08.71**

Born in Bulawayo, Rhodesia, but was spotted playing locally. Comes from Newhaven, East Sussex. Joined as a trainee in July 1988 but signed a professional contract two years later.

**DAVID SAVAGE — STRIKER — D.O.B. 30.07.73**

Signed from Kilkenny City for £3,000 in February 1991. He has Republic of Ireland youth honours. He was born in Dublin.

**WAYNE STEMPE — DEFENDER — D.O.B. 09.09.70**

Former Middlesex U18s and Staines Youth full back who joined as a trainee in July 1988. Signed professional forms in June 1989. He made his League debut at Hull on 28 October 1989.

**BRYAN WADE — STRIKER — D.O.B. 25.06.63**

A former Swindon and Swansea striker who found himself out of work after his contract expired with the Welsh Club. He wrote to Brighton & Hove Albion for a trial and responded by scoring a hat-trick playing for the reserves against Southampton. He was then offered a full-time contract and then managed to score all four goals in the win against Newcastle last season.

**SIMON FUNNELL — STRIKER — D.O.B. 08.08.74**

Striker from Shoreham, currently in the second year of his Youth Team apprenticeship.

**JAMIE WILLIAMS — MIDFIELD — D.O.B. 29.12.73**

Born in Wrexham and is currently a member of the Welsh International Youth Squad.

**BRADLEY WOSAHLO — MIDFIELD — D.O.B. 14.02.75**

Ipswich born who signed a Youth Team contract last July.

#### **BARRY LLOYD — MANAGER**

Barry played for Chelsea FC from 1964 to 1969 from Apprentice to Professional status. He made his League début in April 1968 for Chelsea. He was transferred to Fulham in 1969 for a fee of £30,000 where he was Captain of the Club until Alan Mullery joined and took over from him.

He played for Fulham in their 3rd Division Promotion side during season 1970/71 and was substitute against West Ham in the 1975 FA Cup Final. He joined Hereford United in 1976/77 and then Brentford in 1977 and helped gain promotion from the 4th to the 3rd Division. He played in America for Houston Hurricanes in 1978. He finished playing in 1978 after developing a back injury and went into non-league management with Yeovil Town from 1978-81 and then Worthing from 1981 to 1986. He has a full FA Coaching Badge (1977) and has made 350 League and Cup appearances. He succeeded Alan Mullery as Team Manager of Brighton & Hove Albion in January 1987.

#### **MARTIN HINSHELWOOD — COACH**

Martin joined Brighton in June 1987 and masterminded the Club's promotion campaign with Barry Lloyd. Martin was forced to retire from playing at the top level after sustaining a knee injury at the age of 27 in 1979 after 10 seasons with Crystal Palace. He coached Palace's youth team until 1982 and then spent three years in non-league football coaching Barking, Dorking and Kingstonians. He was appointed Chelsea's reserve team coach in 1985 and remained at Stamford Bridge until accepting an offer with Brighton.

#### **LARRY MAY — COACH**

Larry joined the Club from Sheffield Wednesday in September 1988, for £175,000 after a career spanning 364 league games and 19 league goals with Leicester, Barnsley, Sheffield Wednesday and Brighton. He made 24 appearances for Albion in 1988-89. After sustaining a knee injury he needed an operation and was advised to cease playing. He is a full badge coach whose main responsibility has been to run the reserves in the Football Combination.

#### **STEVE DELL — GOALKEEPER**

The longest serving player who has been with the Club throughout their rise from Junior to Senior football. He has made over 200 Senior appearances for the Club.

#### **JASON MORLEY — DEFENDER**

Local product of the Club youth system, he graduated to the first team in the second half of the season.

#### **PETER ROBERTS — DEFENDER**

Former Eastbourne Town and Hailsham Town player. He is a most consistent performer who has been a regular for the Sussex FA representative team.

#### **MATT JONES — DEFENDER**

Former Eastbourne United player. A strong rugged defender who has been a tower of strength in the passage to the final.

#### **PAUL STEVENS — MIDFIELD**

Versatile player, formerly with Hailsham Town, who has also spent a large part of the season at left back.

#### **MICK GREEN — MIDFIELD**

Team Captain who has been inspirational during Langney's rise to senior status. Former goalkeeper at senior level with Eastbourne United, Eastbourne Town and Hastings Town, he has now made over 200 senior appearances for the Club scoring over 70 goals, and has made several appearances for the Sussex FA side.

#### **PAUL CALLINGHAM — MIDFIELD**

Stylish player who can perform equally well in defence or attack. Nicknamed 'Rocky' he has now been with the Club for five years.

**PAUL FILSELL — MIDFIELD**

Former Hailsham Town, Eastbourne Town and Whitehawk midfielder. Very strong, determined player who joined Langney Sports during last season. He has also represented Sussex at Senior level.

**DANNY ASHWORTH — MIDFIELD**

Former Crawley Town and Eastbourne United winger who has gained a reputation as one of the quickest players in the County. Another who has represented Sussex this season.

**NIGEL HOLE — FORWARD**

Former Little Common and Eastbourne Town striker, who has a remarkable scoring record since joining Langney Sports three years ago, averaging nearly a goal a game in over 100 appearances for the Club.

**DERRICK SMITH — FORWARD**

Former Eastbourne United and Eastbourne Town striker who signed for Langney Sports during last season. Another striker who has scored consistently throughout his career.

**JOE O'NEIL — MIDFIELD**

Rejoined the Club from Eastbourne Town in the Summer, having played a considerable part in Langney's rise through the ranks.

**SHANE KENWARD — DEFENDER**

Former East Sussex Schools Captain. He rejoined Langney Sports this season after a short spell with Eastbourne Town.

**PETER CHERRY — MANAGER**

The longest serving Manager in the 'Unijet' Sussex County Football League who has guided the Club through the ranks from Division Three to their current Division One status.
